WORKSHOP POLICY

Registration:

Payment in full at time of registration is required to hold your place in the workshop. Payment may be made in cash, check, credit-debit card or Bayberry Gift Card. We will give you a supply list and homework requirements (if any) when you register.

Workshop Classes require that your supplies be purchased at our shop. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and consideration.

Cancellations:

A full refund will be given when Bayberry Knitting cancels a scheduled workshop. Typically, cancellations will occur due to low enrollment or inclement weather. No other refunds are possible. If a student is unable to attend a workshop because of an emergency, the student may make up the workshop with any later workshop that we offer of the same value.

Workshop Size:

The minimum size for a workshop is three (3) students. The maximum size is six (6) students to insure ample one-on-one time with the instructor.

Waiting List:

In the event that a workshop is full when you register, we will place your name on the waiting list if you so request. If a cancellation occurs, we will let you know by phone and-or e-mail and give you the option to register in the workshop. So, yes, our schedule is open to additional workshops that our customers may be interested in.

Our “Open Scheduling” Policy:

If you see a workshop in our description listing that you would like to attend but find that it is not included in our schedule, please ask us to schedule the workshop. We will do everything we can to schedule it at a time agreeable to you and anyone else who may be interested.

Private Instruction:

May be arranged upon request. Current fee: \$30 per hour.

Material Discounts:

Upon registering for a workshop, you will receive a 10% discount on workshop supplies. This discount may not be combined with any other discounts.

SKILL LEVELS FOR KNITTING

BEGINNER ●○○○: Projects for first time knitters using basic knit and purl stitches. Minimal Shaping

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○: Projects using basic stitches, repetitive stitch patterns, simple color changes and simple shaping and finishing.

INTERMEDIATE ●●●○: Projects with a variety of stitches, such as basic cables and lace, simple intarsia, double-pointed needles and knitting in the round needle techniques, mid-level shaping and finishing.

EXPERIENCED ●●●●: Projects using advanced techniques and stitches, such as short rows, fair isle, more intricate intarsia, cables, lace patterns and numerous color changes.

OUR WORKSHOPS

BEYOND SCARVES I

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit and Purl

Materials Required:

Yarn: Bulky Weight: 440-550-770 yards

Needles: Size 11 circular needles, and Tapestry Needle.

Yarn: Worsted Weight: 600-800 yards

Needles: Size 9 - 32" circular needle.

Description: Bored with knitting scarves and hats? Have you made so many that you can no longer give them away? Then you are ready to go "Beyond Scarves"! While making a simple Shrug/vest you will learn to read a pattern, knit a gauge and finish your garment.



BEYOND SCARVES II

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$60 SESSIONS: 3 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Beginner who can do all in Beyond Scarves I (check with Betty).

Materials Required: 822 -1370 yds of Greenland or other worsted weight yarn; needles sized 6 & 8 or ANY TO ATTAIN GAUGE (bring 5's and 7's to class just in case they are needed); tape measure or other rule to measure gauge; tapestry needle for finishing.

Description: Ready for the next step Beyond Scarves? Join this class to continue expanding your knitting skills. We will actually take this pattern down a step and knit it in stockinette instead of the pictured cable. (See store sample... and you can try it with the cable once you are comfortable with the skill level.) New skills will include: paired decreases, shaping an armhole and shaping a neckline. You will also reinforce new/old skills; knitting that pesky gauge and finishing the garment (mattress stitch and blocking).



BEYOND SCARVES III

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$60 SESSIONS: 3 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl and paired decreases.

HOMEWORK: Knit a swatch on scrap yarn (20 stitches x 26 rows)

Materials Required:

Yarn: 550-880 yards of WW yarn for 36" bust (more if you are planning to make a larger size).

Needle: Size 6 needles

Size D crochet hook and 2 buttons

Gauge: 5.5 stitches = 1"

Description:

It is easier than you might think to decipher a Japanese knitting pattern – there are no words to misunderstand! Instead of following written directions, you will learn to “read” a schematic and stitch-pattern chart to create an open-front vest for your favorite young women. If you prefer, however, with some simple changes in the numbers, it is easy to adapt the pattern for yourself!

BRATTLEBORO HAT

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl, decreasing, picking up stitches and knitting in the round.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 215 yards of worsted weight

Needles: Size 8-16" circular. Size 8 DPN's

Markers, 2-1" buttons; tapestry needle

Description: This hat is knitted in two directions: a ribbed band is worked from side to side to create the brim and stitches are picked up along one side for the moss stitch crown. A button tab at the side gives this simple design a twist.

CHEVRON SHELL

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

**Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Basic stitches, repetitive stitch patterns, simple shaping and finishing**Materials Required:**

Yarn: 515-1133 yards W/W cotton blend yarn. We have chosen Grass or Jeannee yarn for this project.

Needles: Size 9 – 16” and 24” circular needles.

1 Stitch Marker

Description: Shaped by its side panels, this flattering cotton blend Chevron shell will make a cool and comfortable addition to your summer wardrobe. It works up quickly in a short, long or sleeveless version. Pattern included in class fee.**COMBINATION CONTINENTAL KNITTING**

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$25 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Must know basic stitches, repetitive stitch patterns.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: Approximately 150-200 yards of W/W yarn. We have chosen Encore for this particular project.

Needles: Size 8 Needles

Description: Have you ever seen someone knitting with yarn traveling from the left instead of the right or watched someone do Fair Isle with one strand of yarn in each hand? This class teaches the combination/continental way of knitting. By making a practice swatch, you will learn to knit, purl, rib and decrease in the combination style. The class project (Box Stitch Scarf) should make you proficient enough to be able to add combination/continental knitting to your repertoire.

CRISS-CROSS SCARF

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$25 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

**Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Basic knit and purl and yarn over.**Materials Required:**

For this project we have chosen either Pagewood Handpainted yarn or Boku.

Yarn: 150 yards of WW color A; 150 yards of WW color B

(If you're brave use two skeins of yarn that don't appear to match.)

Needles: Size 5 – 40" circular

Description: As a beginner knitter you can really WOW your family and friends with this beautiful scarf that looks very difficult to make. It's a lot of fun to make and you can also use a lighter weight yarn if you'd like a more delicate look as an accessory scarf. Pattern included with class fee.**HOMEWORK:** Loosely cast on 282. With Color A Knit rows 1 & 2. With Color B Knit rows 3 & 4.**DASHING-FINGERLESS MITT**

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 1.5 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl, cast on, bind off, cabling, picking up stitches.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: Worsted weight yarn-approximately 170 yards.

Needle: Size 7 or 8-32" circular (or size needle required for gauge) stitch markers, yarn needle, cable needle.

Gauge: 20 stitches to 4 inches over stockinette.

Description: Dashing is a "male" version of Fetching-a longer cabled fingerless mitt that can really be for anyone! In this class you will learn how to knit the mitt using magic loop method-one circular needle.

ENDPAPER MITTS

INTERMEDIATE ●●●○

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knitting in the round, (DPN, 2 circulars, magic loop) some experience reading charts.

Materials Required:

Yarn: Fingering/sock weight, (180 yds in each of 2 colors); additional WW yarn, with appropriate needles, is needed to learn the cast-on and bind off techniques

Needles: Size 0 (for ribbings only); for main body of mitts you need to check the pattern, as the needle size is determined by the glove size you need. Circs or DPN's can be used according the method you use when knitting in the round.

Note: Gauge in color work may be easier to maintain on wooden or bamboo needles rather than slick metal.

Description: Fingerless gloves with a touch of Fair Isle, these mitts are a good introduction to the art of Fair Isle knitting. With its simple charted pattern, this project moves quickly, and the changes make you want to knit 'just one more row'. Simple shaping insures that there is no right/left-hand confusion.

FEE: \$60 SESSIONS: 3 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

**ENTRELAC SCARF**

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

Prerequisite Workshops: Knit, purl, SSK, k2tog, picking up stitches.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 2 skeins of Plymouth Boku yarn or multi yarn choice.

Needles: Size 8 needles

Description: Scarves are a great way to learn how to knit, but what do you do when you have knit enough basic scarves to last you and your family for years? Try our Entrelac scarf workshop and not only make a beautiful and stylish new scarf but learn a new knitting technique at the same time. 'Entrelac' is a knitting technique that shows you how to create something with more texture in it; and once you have completed this scarf, you'll be able to use this technique in other knitted items such as blankets, wraps, sweaters, vests and socks. Pattern included in class fee.

FEE: \$35 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



FAIR ISLE SCARF

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Chart reading, knitting in the round.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 600 yards main color (MC)

1 skein each colors B, C, D, (see pattern for details)

Needles: Size 6-24” circular needle or size needed to get gauge. Gauge is 5 ½ sts/inch.

Description: Working with more than one color adds a new dimension to your knitting. Learn the Fair Isle technique by making this easy scarf. It is knit in the round, which is the easiest way to learn Fair Isle--also both sides look the same! Pattern available with class. Upcoming classes will include how to knit a beret and mittens to match the scarf.

FELTED CLOGS (SLIPPERS)

INTERMEDIATE ●●●○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl

Materials Required:

YARN: Approximately 580 yards 100% wool (More yarn for larger sizes)

NEEDLES: Size 13 16” and 24” circular

Description: Keep your feet warm, cozy and comfortable this winter. This felt clog slipper from Fiber Trends is a quick knit. They also make a great gift for family and friends. Pattern included in workshop fee.

FELTED ENTRELAC MARKET BAG

INTERMEDIATE ●●●○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Entrelac Scarf Class or knit, purl, k2tog, SSK, picking up stitches.

Materials Required:

Yarn: Approximately 925 yards of 100% wool, worsted weight yarn. You can either use a multi-colored yarn like Boku or a few different colors such as:

MC-250 yards, CC A-175 yards, CC B - 250 yards, CC C - 250 yards.

Needles: Size 8 needles

Description: Come join us for some felting fun. If you enjoyed making the Entrelac scarf, you will love making this bag. You'll learn how to work Entrelac in the round and produce a beautiful eco-friendly bag to take shopping. Pattern included in class fee.



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FETCHING FINGERLESS GLOVES

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$35 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 3 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Cast on, bind off, knit, purl, comfortable with circular needle and picking up stitches.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 130 yards of worsted weight

Needles: Size 6-32" circular

Cable needle; spare needle or DPN's (2)

Description: Fetching is a cute and fast fingerless mitt pattern used with worsted weight yarn, although you can use chunky weight yarn & size 8 needle. In this class, we'll knit the mitt using the magic loop method. It's ideal to learn the magic loop method and simple cables.

During the class you will cast on for the first mitt, learn magic loop and work through the mitt during class.

FINISHING**NOT APPLICABLE****FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** N/A**HOMEWORK:**

Please bring a project you need help finishing or 2 each of the following swatches:

20 stitches x 15 rows of stockinette stitch;

20 stitches x 15 rows of garter stitch;

20 stitches x 15 rows of ribbed stitch (2k and 2p);

20 stitches x 15 rows of seed stitch.

Materials Required:

Appropriate yarn for the sweater finishing or swatch yarn.

Steel Yarn Needle.

Description: Love making sweaters but hate sewing them together? Learn all the tips and tricks to making your sweater finishing easy and professional looking. Techniques will be discussed and demonstrated, but feel free to bring along a project that needs finishing to the workshop.

FLIRTY PONCHO: ADULT OR CHILD**ADVANCED BEGINNER** ●●○○**FEE: \$25 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Work in the round, increase and change yarns.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: Light weight worsted 400 yds MC and 300 yds CC.

Needles: Size 7 circular; cable length 16" and 24"- 40".

Description: Using a basic top-down design that has center front and back increases, an angled stripe mid-way down and a matching border stripe, this poncho can be created in a myriad of ways. Use your imagination to change the stripe and border pattern stitches, the way increases are done, weight of the yarn and size needles you use. (Stitch and border pattern books will be available to give you ideas. You are also invited to bring your favorite stitch pattern books to share.)

I-CORD BRAIDED SCARF

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$25 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit**Materials Required:**

Needles: Size 13 (bulky) or 15 (super bulky) knitting needles (straight or circular);

Yarn: 3 skeins of bulky or super bulky yarn. (Can be all the same color or three separate colors)

Description: Looking for the next step in scarf knitting? Have you wondered what I-cords are, how to make them and what to do with them? Come join us for this fun workshop on creating I-cords and then braiding them together into a beautiful and very warm scarf.**INTRO TO FAIR ISLE SWATCH**

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Good to know, but not a necessity: how to cast on, join yarn for circular knitting, and read a chart.**Materials Required:** Ten yards of each of several different colors in the same weight yarn; knitting needles appropriate to the weight of yarn being used. Gauge is not an issue in making this swatch.**Description:** Working with more than one color adds a new dimension to your knitting. Learn the Fair Isle technique by making this swatch. It is knit in the round, which is the easiest way to learn Fair Isle. Also, if finished as a potholder, both sides look the same! Pattern available with class. Upcoming classes will include one that uses this technique in a hat or mittens.**INTRO TO INTARSIA**

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: NONE**Materials Required:** Five yards each of 3-4 different colors in the same or similar weights; knitting needles appropriate for the yarn being used. Gauge is not an issue in this swatch.**Description:** Intarsia is defined as a method of knitting with a number of colors, in which a separate length or ball of yarn is used for each area of color. There are no floats across the back of your work using this type of color work.

Unlock the skills being this technique by knitting a swatch chosen from the design patterns available in class. You will learn to follow a color chart and how to change colors in midstream, so to speak, without leaving a hole in your knitting.

INTRO TO LACE**ADVANCED BEGINNER** ●●○○**FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Knit, purl, yarn over, k2tog, SSK**Materials Required:**

Yarn: 200-300 yards cotton/linen yarn.

Needles: Size 3

Description: Learn how to read charts and make beautiful lace creations in this exciting class. You can choose one of four different beginner lace patterns to use in making an attractive and useful lace hand towel. I suggest using Euroflax sport weight or Jeannee yarn for this project. Pattern included with class fee.**KNECESSARY KNITTING KNOWLEDGE****BEGINNER** ●○○○**FEE: \$35 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** None**Materials Required:**

Yarn: Worsted weight scrap yarn

Needles: Three sets of needles 2 sizes apart (ie: 5,7,9)

Description: What if the yarn I want to use isn't the recommended yarn – can I change yarns? Do I have enough for this project? What will happen if I wash this in the washing machine? Why don't my sweaters look like the pictures on the patterns? This class will answer all these questions and more. There will be a "hands on" section so bring yarn and needles for swatching.**KITCHENER STITCH TECHNIQUES****ALL SKILL LEVELS****FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** NONE**Materials Required:** Two swatches of the same yarn, one on a stitch holder and one still on the needles, about 1/2 a yard of contrasting yarn, and a tapestry needle..**Description:** 'Graft together using the Kitchener stitch'; a term that can scare off all but the most determined beginning knitters. Actually, it's a dreaded phrase for a relatively easy technique. Come with two swatches (following directions below) and you will be given instructions and hints so you can master the Kitchener stitch.

LUSH-IOUS SWIRL COWL

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○○

FEE: \$25 SESSIONS: 1 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knitting in the round, yarn over, k2tog, some chart reading

Materials Required:

Yarn: Approximately 300 yards of worsted weight yards (We used Malabrigo silky merino)

Needles: Size 8-16”Circular

Description: This class is a great way to learn chart reading in moderation. The project is small and doesn’t require too much time. It’s also a great project to whip up for last minute gifts.

LEARN TO KNIT - RIGHT

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 90 min

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:

Materials Required:

Description: Experience how therapeutic and rewarding knitting can be. Learn to knit as we teach you to make a face cloth. You will learn to read a pattern, cast on, knit, purl, bind off and block your finished piece. Materials and pattern included in class fee.



LEARN TO KNIT-LEFT

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 90 mins

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Must be left-handed.

Materials Required: Materials and pattern included in class fee.

Description: Are you a left-handed person who wants to learn to knit but think you can’t? This is the class for you. You will learn the long-tail cast on in combination style, knit, purl, garter stitch and how to bind off and weave a seam. Pre-requisite must be left-handed.



MAKE A HAT

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, purl.

Materials Required: See individual pattern for materials list.

Description: Come join us for some hat making fun. Even if you have never made a hat before, you will enjoy this workshop. Pick a pattern from our selection or bring your own to knit. We have patterns for adults and children to choose from. Learn the basics of knitting hats in the round and create a fun fashion accessory for you and your family.

MITTENS FOR EVERYONE

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$35 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl and knitting in the round

Materials Required:

Yarn: 150-300 yards of worsted weight yarn.

Needles: Size 3 & 5 double pointed needles or your favorite needles for knitting in the round.

Description: Use this mitten pattern to knit mittens for all your favorite people – from small children to adults. In addition to being a quick-to-knit mitten, it has one of the easiest thumbs ever.

MULTI-DIRECTIONAL SCARF

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, Purl

Materials Required:

Yarn: 3 skeins of worsted weight yarn (130 yards each).

Needles: Size 6 needles

Description: Interesting pattern, great gift - here is a scarf that works up quickly and easily. You also can choose to make it part of a larger set with leg & wrist warmers, hat or frilled gloves. Either way you will have a great gift for a special person – or for yourself. Shop model made up on Twilleys-Freedom Spirit. PATTERN INCLUDED IN CLASS FEE.

PERSONAL FOOTPRINT SOCKS

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$60 SESSIONS: 3 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Familiarity with working in the round on 2 circular needles.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 400 yards of Worsted Weight yarn,
Manila folder.

Needles: Size 8-16” or 24”circular (Sock yarn and needles available for student who want to use fingering weight yarn.)

Description: Knitting Socks brings to mind that dreaded term “turning a heel”-right? Not necessarily, not if you learn to knit this sock. Using worsted weight yarn you will learn the process from tracing an outline of your own foot to completing a well fitting sock. Pattern included in class fee.

Summer Modification: To make a summertime Personal Footprint Sock appropriate to wear with capris we will start with the basic techniques for the toe, foot and heel using sock weight cotton blend yarn. We will then substitute a “crop-sock” leg for the traditional leg.

PATTY SCARF (BEADED)

ADVANCED BEGINNER ●●○○

FEE: \$30 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Knit, purl, make a cable, must have knitted with beads.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 185 yards of fingering/sport weight yarn
Needles: Size 6 needles

RAMBLING ROWS AFGHAN

BEGINNER ●○○○

FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs



Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Cast on, knit, bind off, decrease and pick up stitches.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 5 colors worsted weight-amount varies based on size suggested. Using a different weight will result in a different size for your afghan. When you pick yarn, all yarn should be the same weight.

Needle: Size 8-24” circular-or size needed for gauge

Yarn needle, scissors, (1) split ring marker and (2) regular markers

(Gauge is 4 stitches to the inch, although this can be variable depending on yarn selected.)

Description: Rambling Rows is a modular garter stitch afghan available in 3 sizes-baby, lap or afghan. This afghan is knit in squares, picking up stitches off of the previous squares, so there is no sewing! This class is perfect for beginners who are ready to move on to some new techniques such as decreases, picking up stitches etc. In the first class we will talk about picking colors and start the first square. The second class will cover adding new squares based on the provided chart !

REVERSIBLE STAGGERED CABLE SCARF

RUCHED KEYHOLE SCARF

Description: Scarves, scarves, scarves. We’ve all made a multitude of them. Here is a slightly different take on them—a scarf that stays put—and is attractive, cozy and warm. Knit of a worsted weight yarn that combines merino and silk, this scarf will make a drab day shine.

SHELL FRINGED SCARF

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Cast on and knit.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: 400 yards of fingering-sport yarn

Needles: Size 2 or 3 single pointed

Beads: 2480-6mm beads (150gms)

HOMEWORK: Pre-string beads prior to class.

Description: Love the look of our knit and beaded scarves; it's easier than you think. Make it for yourself or give it as a gift. Great class to learn the technique of knitting with beads.

**SPAGHETTI HAT**

FEE: \$35 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs

**Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Knitting in the round on 2 circulars.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: Plymouth Encore (or equivalent yarn) one skein color A, one skein color B;

Needles: Size 4 & 6 DPN and Size 4 & 6-16" circular

Pattern included with class fee.

Description: Spaghetti—fun to eat—now fun to wear!!!! Make a Spaghetti Hat for a special little girl (or a special big girl!). Pattern skills you will learn include how to knit a top-down hat using Emily Ocker's cast on and how to make I-cord.

SPIRAL TUBE SOCK

Description: This sock avoids the heel altogether. It is knit as a tube with a spiral pattern and the sizes ranging from a child's to a large adult's.**START SMALL, THINK BIG**

Description: Do you want to knit a sweater but feel intimidated, not only by the amount of knitting necessary but by the lack of technical knowledge? The techniques taught in this sampler have been planned to introduce you to those necessary to knit a seamless raglan sweater, but they can be applied to any sweater you may knit. In addition to teaching you to follow basic directions, The Sweater Workshop, by Jacqueline Fee includes sidebars with more advanced techniques, making this a good book to include in your basic knitting library.

TOP-DOWN MAGIC LOOP SOCKS**ADVANCED BEGINNER** ●●○○**FEE: \$60 SESSIONS: 3 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs**

Prerequisite Workshops/Skills: Cast on, Bind off, knit, purl, comfortable with circular needles, increase/decrease and picking up stitches.

Materials Required:

Yarn: Approximately 400 yards of fingering weight yarn.

Needles: Size 1-32" circular (if you knit loose)

Size 2-32" circular (if you knit tight)

Yarn needle and stitch markers.

Description: Socks are a quick, fun project that is portable and fast to complete. Socks are also a great way to buy and use yarn with funky colors. In this class, you will learn to knit top-down socks using the magic loop method (one-needle socks). This class is three sessions to walk you through the method and completing one sock (and start the next one)!

A) Size 6 cabled needle:

--- 32" cable if doing one at a time

--- 40" cable if doing two at a time

B) 60 yards per sock of worsted weight (sample was done with Cascade 220 Superwash)

--- if doing two socks at a time, the yarn must be divided into
2 (60 yard) balls.

C) Stitch markers

NOTE: Must purchase yarn and needles at the time of sign up. Yarn must be wound into two cakes before class.**Description:** This class is for knitters who:

A) are intimidated by, or uncomfortable using, double pointed needles, or

B) would like to learn what Magic Loop is all about, or

C) tried cuff-down socks and found dealing with gussets too fiddly, or

D) would like to have two socks that are the same size, or

E) don't like doing the same thing twice (ie, the second sock), or

F) made cuff-down socks and ran out of yarn before finishing the toe or made too-short a leg and ended up with lots of yarn left over.



We will be making a child-sized, worsted weight, toe-up sock (either one at a time or two at a time, your choice) using the Magic Loop method (one long, circular needle). Specific skills taught include a toe-up cast on, Make 1 Left and Make 1 Right increases, turning a heel using wrap & turn short rows, creating a slip-stitch heel flap, and doing a stretchy bind-off. .

TWINED KNITTED MITTENS

Description: Take this class to make this fantastic Schaefer Yarn scarf you will absolutely love to make and wear. This pattern is fun and easy once you get into the groove of the repeat. first class. (approx. 320 beads). Pattern included in class fee.



URBAN GLOVE**ADVANCED BEGINNER** ●●○○**FEE: \$40 SESSIONS: 2 LENGTH OF SESSIONS: 2 hrs****Prerequisite Workshops/Skills:** Knit, purl and knitting in the round.**Materials Required:**

Yarn: 200 yds of worsted weight

Needles: Size 3-16" and 24" circular

Size 3 DPN's

Tapestry needle

One yard of waste yarn

Two stitch markers

Gauge: 6 stitches per inch in stockinette

NOTE: You can use 4 or 5 DPN's, 2 circulars or magic loop to knit the hand part of the mitten. The fingers will be knit with DPN's.**Description:** Warmth vs finger movement; until now this was a choice we had to make each winter, until the advent of the Urban Glove. A combination of fingerless glove and flip-top mitten-convenience and warmth combined.
